**Petition for a hearing pertaining CPCE capacity in support of the Green New Deal**

Dear Mr. Governor Hogan:

In pursuant to our letter dated February 18, 2019, we like to submit our petition for a meeting regarding our CPCE process with very specific venue to corroborate the solid feasibility of the New Green Deal by facts and reasoning.

In this respect, we recently informed many Congressional Committees as well as great number of Congressional members of the United States' Senate and House of Representatives individually of our CPCE zero-carbon-emission process with its first time economical profitable advantages as of February 14, 2019 (vide enclosed copies), because CPCE performs all aspects of the Green New Deal and exceeds the anticipated objectives in some perspectives. The specific advantages are (i)around-the-clock availability for ca. 340 days a year; (ii)independence on geographic location, season, time and ambient conditions of the plants; (iii)yet with tremendous economic benefit i.e. no need for Federal or State subsidies at all (except for loan guarantee support of DOE to the first prototype kind of the plant); (iv) noticeable shorter expected time frame for the completion of retrofitting and upgrading of all the existing fossil energy power and chemical commercial plants currently in operation to zero-carbon-emission as early as 2030; (v)these, in addition to the new plants according to the CPCE's super-efficient hydrogen based fossil power plant in the United States.

With the present letter we request respectfully for a meeting with you at your convenient venue and time, preferably before the New Green Deal Bill is presented officially to the Congress. A similar petition for hearing regarding the CPCE capacity to the support of the Green New Deal will be dispatched to the United States' Senate and House in due course. In this hearing we want to submit our circumstantial indications to the potential thwarting ambitions of the oil and gas exporting countries like Russia and OPEC countries, along the oil and gas entities, as well the nuclear power generation entities, who, according to our presumptions, would had halted the advance of Clean Energy, zero-carbon-emission, re-use of the captured carbon dioxide as a new fossil energy resource, Clean Coal for nearly over ten years successfully.
